## Introduction

---




At the end of 2024, we were notified by TEQSA that we had been granted university status and this was announced publicly at the beginning of 2025. We have therefore used our new name, Australian University of Theology (AUT) in this report, although in 2024 our name was still Australian College of Theology (ACT).








The report provides details of AUT Research and Scholarship publications for 2024. In keeping with past years, the AUT Research Department collects and analyses publications and related scholarly activities for members of the AUT Consortium, including permanent, casual and adjunct faculty with an association with AUT and its Affiliated Colleges.

To meet the definition of 'research,' a publication needs to demonstrate substantive new knowledge or the use of existing knowledge in a new and creative way so as to generate new concepts, methodologies and/or understandings. Publications that apply existing knowledge to church and other professional contexts, and/or synthesise existing knowledge, in ways that do not demonstrate substantive new knowledge, are classified as 'scholarship.'

In making assessments of individual publications, the AUT Research Department considers the output itself, the quality of the outlet in which the output was published, the intended audience of the output and the weightiness of the subject matter and argumentation of the output. The AUT Journals and Publishers List is used as a guide, but it is not the primary basis for decisions. Rather, the list is a professional development tool for AUT academics to learn more about typical university research assessment processes, and to encourage them to consider highly regarded journals and publishers for future publications. The AUT list of journals reflects a similar list developed by the Council of Deans of Theology of Australia.

The results of applying the 'research' and 'scholarship' criteria to 2024 publication outputs are presented in this 2024 Research and Scholarship Report. Almost all items recorded are in the field of Religious Studies (ASCED 091703).

In Research there are four sub-categories: books , book chapters , journal articles , and refereed conference proceedings.

In Scholarship there are eight sub-categories: books , book chapters , journal articles , refereed conference proceedings, edited books , conference presentations , book reviews , and dictionary/handbook entries .

When refereed conference proceedings have been published as edited book volumes with an ISBN, as is usually the case in Religious Studies, individual contributions have been included in our count as book chapters - hence the reason for the zero values reported here (despite the higher values in this category in some other disciplines). Papers presented at conferences which have not yet been published are recorded as conference presentations. These are often revised and subsequently published as peer-reviewed journal articles or book chapters which are then categorised as research or scholarship, as appropriate.



Categorisation of journals and publishers is updated regularly by the AUT Research Department, and these lists are able to be accessed on the AUT website at <https://www.aut.edu.au/research/publications/>

In terms of Table 1, multiple authored items are only counted once. Scores are weighted five points per book (in accordance with common academic practice) and weighted to adjust for non-AUT authors, and rounded to one decimal place.
